4. The sources of growth: "imgr" - the newly coming immigrants from Old World; "chldr" - the USA'-born children of current members of the Church; "cnvrt" - converts to Eastern Christianity who was born and raised in other religious traditions. This includes also those who came to Orthodox Church through the mixed "Orthodox-Non-Orthodox" marriages.
